

Parents' Right to Know Act

Overview

The Parents' Right to Know Act (SB48/Act 2024-35) requires all public schools to post current adopted curricula on school websites and that access to online curricula is available to students, parents, or guardians of enrolled students. The content standards and curricula for Gadsden City Schools align with the Alabama State Department of Education's Courses of Study, the Alabama Comprehensive Assessment Program (ACAP), and the American College Test (ACT).
